The Bandoneon is one of our national instruments, which came to Argentina together with the European immigrants, during the 19th century.

The bandoneon used to be a cult instrument, used mainly for religious compositions, but when it arrived in Argentina, its destiny took a resounding turn, since it found its new life partner, the Argentinian tango. The fusion of tango with the bandoneon gave rise to a beautiful and unique style, something never before known to mankind. The bandoneon traveled the same path as those European vines that stepped on Argentinian soil more than 400 years ago, and shares with them the same glorious destiny, that of a unique and incomparable creation.
