NEE-AN-DOO

The Nee-an-doo (ñandú) is a large flightless bird related to the ostrich and emu, commonly seen in Argentina. It normally feeds on insects, especially those that inhabit vineyards, which is why it has become a specialist in discovering vineyards over the years. Some farmers even follow in their footsteps, to be led to unknown vineyards, with quality grapes. This is why the Nee-an-doo is also known as “the guide of the vineyards”.
